WATER TO OUR BENEFICIARIES!

Safe Water is one of the most basic necessities that slum dwellers lack completely and are always subject to the vagaries of water deprivation. It is the single biggest cause of illnesses that can often lead to death of both, children and adults. Parinaam and Ujjivan have entered into a partnership with Hindustan Unilever Ltd. and will provide their customers and staff with interest free loans to purchase the safe water device known as "Pureit". The device is especially useful for our poor as it needs neither, running water (tap connection) nor electricity, to provide water that is clean and germ free.

Month of June

Healthcare was the focus of this month with Parinaam conducting 3 camps for the Ujjivan customers, 1 for our 2 new slums in the UUPP program (where we removed a spider that had lodged itself in a little boy's ear for three months), a dental camp for our Drumshed families, and a vaccination camp for all the little kids in Nagara Palya.

A new relationship was born with HUL and Parinaam, enabling us to bring safe water to our beneficiaries. YUM foods and Lifestlye Retail Stores came on board to recruit people from

the micro-finance sector to work in KFC and Lifestyle stores.

Saving accounts are being opened for our Ujjivan customers in 3 branches in Bangalore.

For the month of July we would like to focus on livelihoods and creating linkages with relevant markets for our Ujjivan Customers and UUPP beneficiaries. We also hope to start a "Sports Day" once a month for the Ujjivan branches. Health Camp protocols are being revised & will be implemented immediately.

LIVELIHOOD:

LIFESTYLE: 6 beneficiaries joined a retail outlet store in Bangalore

UNNATI: 5 joined a NGO that trains and places beneficiaries in various livelihoods.

HOPE Foundation: 8 beneficiaries have joined for computer & tailoring training

KFC: 5 beneficiaries joined KFC restaurants in Bangalore.

UUPP: 29 beneficiaries' salaries have increased since April, 2010.
